Since 1988 Paul Gazzola has operated an interdisciplinary and socially engaged practice across art, architecture, performance, installation, choreography, scenographic design, video and theory. Creating and curating solo and community based works for galleries, museums, stages, site-specific settings, print and projection, that have seen presentations and commissions in Australia, Canada, Japan, South Africa, South America, the UK and throughout Europe. He originally trained as a carpenter, holds a B.A. in Performance, is a qualified a Feldenkrais practitioner and in 2004 commenced studies in architecture. The culmination of these varied inquiries - each distinctly exploring the spatial and performative relationships between the body, site, place and the built form - provide a unique platform of knowledge in his working life.
